



Bequest Wording

Thank-you for your interest in leaving a bequest to Osteoporosis Australia. We appreciate your support, and below is suggested wording to include in your will.

To assist us in future planning – and so that we may thank-you – it helps us to know if you have included Osteoporosis Australia in your will. The suggested wording to include in your will is:

For a Pecuniary legacy:

“I bequeath the sum of \$xxxxx and/or xxx% of my residual estate, free of all duties and testamentary expenses, to Osteoporosis Australia, GPO Box 121 Sydney 2001, to be used for the general purposes of the organisation (or to be used for the purposes of medical research), for which the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorized officer of Osteoporosis Australia shall be sufficient discharge to my executor for this bequest.”

For a Residuary estate:

“I bequeath the rest and residue of my estate to Osteoporosis Australia, GPO Box 121 Sydney 2001, to be used for the general purposes of the organisation (or to be used for the purposes of medical research), for which the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorized officer of Osteoporosis Australia shall be sufficient discharge to my executor for this bequest.”
